

Football Score Prediction Truck Contest 2015
RULES

All contestants must be randomly selected by a method pre-approved by SNP. When an entry is selected, the person assigned to that entry, must be the person who participates as the contestant.

Contestant(s) will have a maximum of one (1) opportunity to attempt the contest
